Charlotte Royals Rugby Football Club - \$2,500 Charlotte NAC 2021

To host the 2021 International Gay Rugby North American Championship, showcasing the successful integration of LGBTQ community into the larger metropolitan community.

Freedom Center for Social Justice - \$2,500 Liberating Theologies Speakers Series

To support the Liberating Theologies Speaker Series offering theologians, clerics, activists, and the LGBTQ+ community a safe space to dialogue about and find support around implementing progressive theologies that will help provide healing for traumas and offer hope.

Girls Rock Charlotte - \$4,000 Amplify Activism & Allies

To support ongoing participation of LGBTQ+ youth in our summer camp and workshop programs, and create new curricula that will teach social justice, allyship, and feminism.

PFLAG Charlotte - \$1,500 Intersection of Faith and LGBTQ Identities

To support the third annual community conversation offering a morning of inspiration, encouragement, conversation, and storytelling, including a keynote speaker and a panel of community members from a range of faiths, races, ethnicities, sexual orientation, and gender identities.

Planned Parenthood - \$5,000 Subsidized Transgender Healthcare

To provide reduced rate office visits for hormone therapy services for uninsured patients in Charlotte ensuring that low-income transgender patients in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg community have access to gender-affirming care.

Teen Health Connection - \$2,000 Center for Gender Health

To support the Center for Gender Health where traditional healthcare services are supplemented to provide optimal care for transgender and gender nonconforming adolescents and provide supplemental patient and family education materials and tools.

Time Out Youth - \$3,500 Queer Youth Art & Poetry

To create an opportunity for LGBTQ youth to showcase their talents and perspectives to a wider audience of people to increase awareness and understanding of the lived experiences of LGBTQ youth.

Twirl to the World Foundation - \$5,000 Hardship Assistance Program (Non-COVID)
