Mid-June 2020 Market Highlights and FFTC Investment Pool Performance

Global equity markets continued to rise during the first two weeks of June following strong returns posted for April and May. The S&P 500 was volatile during the two-week period as investors reacted negatively to a possible second wave of coronavirus infections only to rebound on a strong retail sales report and the Federal Reserve's promise to buy corporate bonds under an emergency lending program. The strong performance month-to-date for Emerging Markets is driven mostly by strong returns from China and currency gains from a weaker U.S. dollar.
